

CAREY, BILL AND BENNY  
MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND



The Carey, Bill, and Benny Memorial Scholarship Award was established for graduating students from the Parkway Local Schools that intend to enroll (or have enrolled) in a program of further education expected to last at least two years.

The scholarship is given from the profit of the trust fund established in memory of Carey, Bill, and Benny plus any specific donations. Carey Fosnaugh (Parkway Class of 1968), William Miller (Parkway Class of 1967), and Benny Sapp (Parkway Class of 1967) lost their lives serving their country in the Viet Nam War. A group of Parkway patrons were determined that the memory of these men should never be allowed to fade into the sands of time. Their memory should stand forever as an inspiration to us all and to the future generations at Parkway. In their honor, the Carey, Bill, and Benny Memorial Scholarship Fund was created in 1970.

The scholarship amount represents the annual profits of the trust fund established in the memory of Carey, Bill, and Benny plus any other direct donations.

The following stipulations and plans are made for awarding of the scholarship:

- A. The Mercer County Civic Foundation will provide the check for this scholarship, made payable to the recipient's college account. It will be the recipient's responsibility to send the check to his or her school in time to pay tuition and/or fees.
- B. The recipient of the Carey, Bill, and Benny Memorial Scholarship shall be chosen by a committee of three. The committee will consist of a Parkway administrator, a representative from the Willshire American Legion, and a representative from the Rockford American Legion. A designee may be chosen by the Legions.
- C. The selection of the recipient shall be made on the evaluation of the completed application including a short essay.
- D. The recipient of a scholarship shall be under no obligation to repay the amount granted.
- E. The recipient of the Carey, Bill, and Benny Scholarship shall be recognized at the annual spring graduation ceremony for Parkway High School.
- F. Each candidate seeking the Carey, Bill, and Benny Scholarship must completely fill out the appropriate application. *The completed application must be returned to the Parkway High School guidance office by noon on the last Friday of April.*
