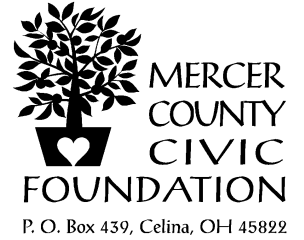


CARL & MICHELE HUBER SCHOLARSHIP
