DEFINITION

COMMUNITY FOUNDATION: a 501(c)3 organization that makes grants for charitable purposes in a specific community or region. The funds available to a community foundation are usually derived from many donors and held in an endowment that is independently administered; income earned by the endowment is then used to make grants. Although a community foundation may be classified by the IRS as a private foundation, most (including our Mercer County Civic Foundation) are public charities and are thus eligible for maximum tax-deductible contributions from the general public.

More than \$297,000 in scholarships were awarded to support students seeking higher education at universities, colleges, and trade schools. Local not-for-profit organizations received a combined total of \$305,000 in support of youth, the elderly, the homeless, health care, the arts and so much more. Donor advised, designated, project and field of interest funds made over \$1,000,000 in philanthropic payouts to support a broad range of worthy causes that touch us locally. All of this was accomplished despite a stock market that created challenges, headaches, and head scratches. While scholarship funds are popular, all of our funds can be established to honor or memorialize the important people in your lives. Ask about Donor Advised, Field of Interest or Designated Funds. Our donor-centric staff is here to answer all your questions.

Giving to an existing fund is as easy as stopping by the office, mailing a check or clicking on the donate button on our website.

NEW FUNDS

Coldwater Dog Park—This fund was established to create a safe environment for the more than 400 licensed dogs in Coldwater to run and play. Not only will it enable four-legged friends to socialize, it will give their owners a chance to meet like-minded community members.

Eric & Donna Hemmelgarn—This fund was established by the Hemmelgarns to provide for the family's annual charitable giving.

Fairgrounds Cornerstone Chapel—Contributions to this fund will support the building of a shelter house open to the public for worship, spiritual events and celebrations. This will also be a joint project between Tri Star Career Compact construction students and St. John Builders.

Fairgrounds Grand Event Center—This fund was established to support the fundraising efforts of the Mercer County Fairgrounds to build a large-scale event center to host trade shows, expos, concerts, and indoor equine and livestock shows. This endeavor is expected to bolster tourism in the community and increase economic growth.

James Leslie Perts Memorial—This fund was established to honor the memory of James Leslie Perts. Funds will be used for the development of a welding/metal testing lab at the Tri Star Career Compact. Mr. Perts was a metallurgist with the St. Mary's Foundry for 47 years, and was impressed with the opportunities Tri Star offers area students.

Bill & Pat Meikle Scholarship—Pat Meikle, Bill Meikle’s widow, established this fund in memory of the work Bill did through the Civic Foundation and the WOEFF Board to support education. It also honors Pat’s accomplishments in support of many initiatives and programs that enhance lives in our community. Students who plan to attend Wright State Lake Campus will be eligible to apply.

Bill’s death in August was deeply felt not only within the Foundation walls, but throughout the Mercer County community.

Wenning Scholarship—This Scholarship was created by Ray and Mary Wenning’s children to honor their parents’ hard work, humble lives and love of their family. It will be awarded to a student who pursues further education in a vocational trade program, including HVAC, electrical, auto-mechanic, plumbing, welding, machining, agriculture, or similar field.

Cheryl Stucke Braun Memorial Scholarship— This scholarship was born from the deep and unending love Bill Braun has for his late wife, Cheryl. She grew up in Cranberry Prairie and graduated from St. Henry High School. She was unable to fulfill her dream of obtaining a history degree, but never lost her love or curiosity to explore historical sites. This scholarship is offered to students in their sophomore year or higher of college who have embraced a love of learning. Special consideration is given to female students from southern Mercer County who are studying history.

Brian Harlamert Scholarship—This scholarship for Coldwater High School athletes was established by Trisha Harlamert in memory of her husband Brian, a loving, trustworthy, and a do-anything-for-you kind of guy. He impacted the lives of many in and out of the classroom as a dedicated teacher at Coldwater Middle School for 27 years. Brian’s passion and love of baseball led him to a successful coaching career as the head Varsity Baseball coach at Coldwater High School for 25 years. He won his first state championship as a coach in 2015 and reached 500 career wins in 2021. In January 2022, he was inducted into the Ohio High School Baseball Coaches Hall of Fame. He empowered his players and coaching staff through his knowledge and positive energy. The scholarship honors the exemplary life Brian led and his dedication to uplifting others.
