The funds available to a community foundation are usually derived from many donors and held in an endowment that is independently administered; income earned by the endowment is then used to make grants. Although a community foundation may be classified by the IRS as a private foundation, most (including our Mercer County Civic Foundation) are public charities and are thus eligible for maximum tax-deductible contributions from the general public.

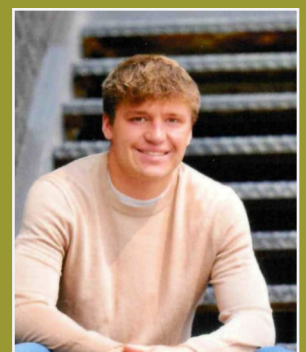

New Funds

Celina Sharks — This fund was established to create a swim and dive team to be part of the Tri-County League. During 2025, 106 swimmers/divers participated on the team. In addition to competing at swim meets, they improved their skill sets, made new friends, and created lasting memories.

Celina Tree Project — In April 2025, Celina was named a Tree City USA. The title acknowledges the city's efforts to plant more trees. To support this designation, local tree enthusiasts created this fund to restore Celina's tree canopy. Residents can apply for a tree to be planted in their yard free-of-charge.

FCI Planning Scholarship – This scholarship was established by Ryan O'Neill and Judy Zehringer to support college students whose ultimate goal is to become a financial planner. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded annually.

Anonymous Donor Advised – This year we also created an anonymous donor advised fund. MCCF realizes that charitable giving can be personal and private. For those who would like to establish a fund, but would like to remain quietly in the background, an anonymous fund is the perfect fit.





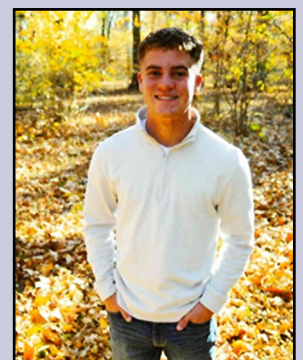

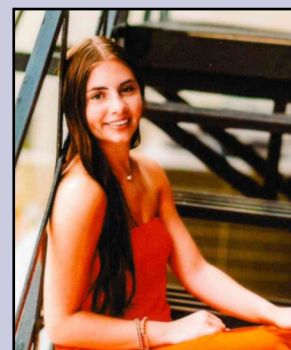
